

DETROIT Data Trend Report 2009-2013

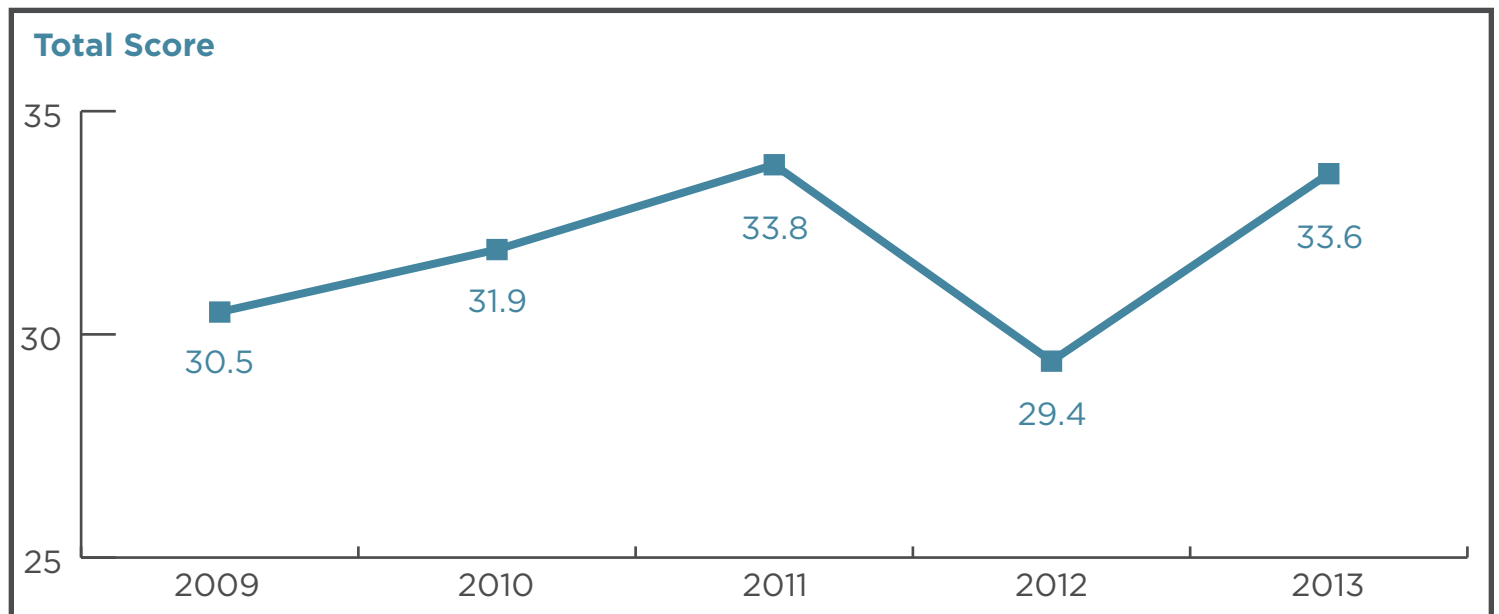
(Detroit-Warren-Livonia, MI)

While Detroit's total score ranks among the bottom 25 metropolitan areas, improvements have been made since 2009. Strengths include a high number of farmers' markets per resident, as well as a high number of recreational facilities per resident including ball diamonds, park playgrounds and park units.

Top four improvements since 2009:

- ✦ The number of farmers' markets per 1,000,000 increased from 6.5 to 16.6.
- ✦ The death rate per 100,000 for cardiovascular disease decreased from 285.5 to 240.7.
- ✦ The death rate per 100,000 for diabetes decreased from 27.2 to 25.0.
- ✦ The percent of residents using public transportation to work increased from 1.5% to 1.6%.

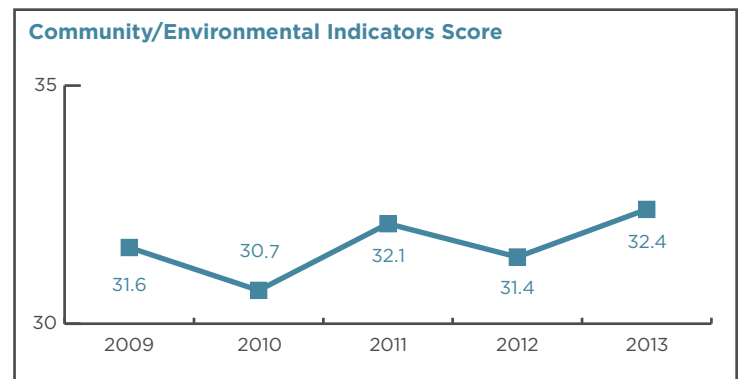
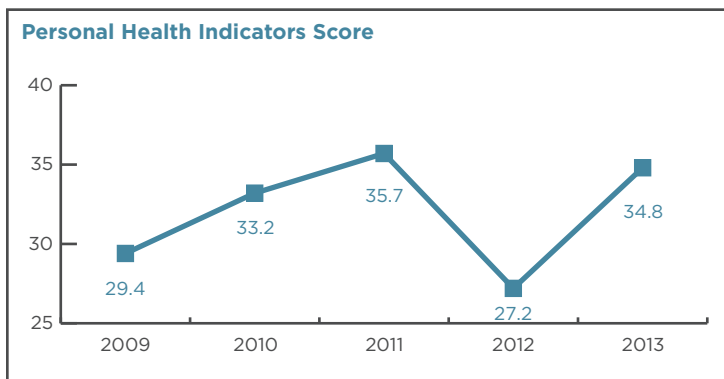
